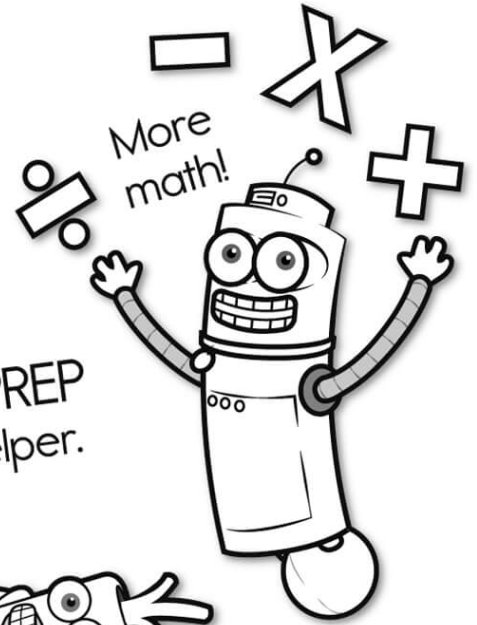
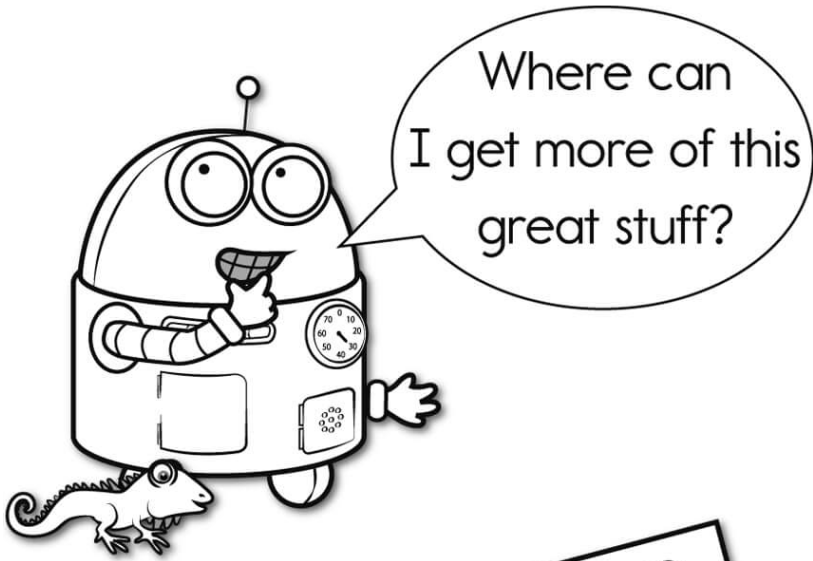


Draw a slide of the shape by moving the shape 1 dot to the right and 3 dots down.

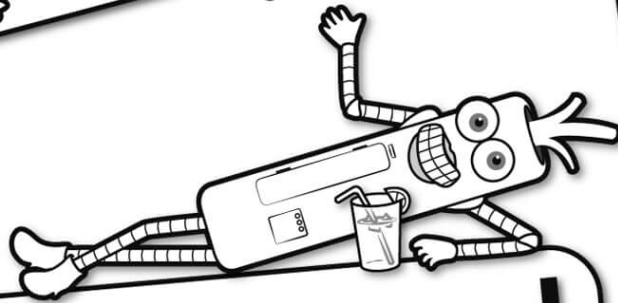

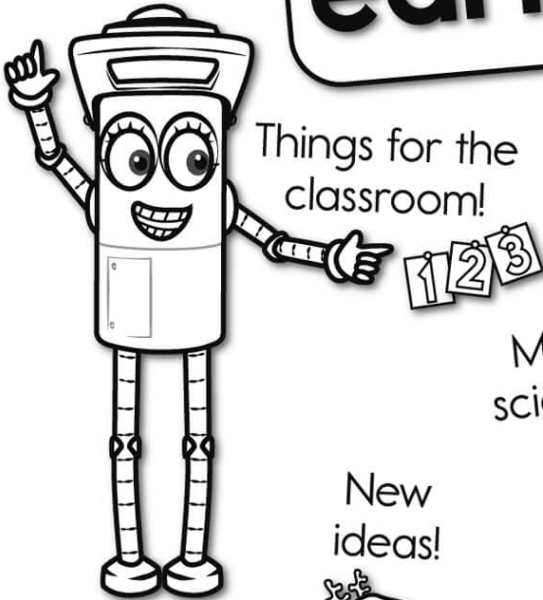

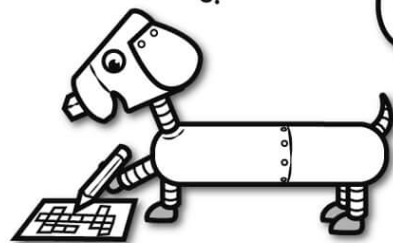
